# A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENTS

#### **DEAR FRIENDS,**

During the past year, the pandemic continued to impose challenges and limitations, but it also brought out the best in our community. As our grant recipients adapted by making innovative adjustments to their programs to help the children and families they serve, we are proud that Near & Far Aid was able to continue our support of those agencies and our neighbors during this global crisis.

Near & Far Aid is an all-volunteer run organization with very low operating costs, which enables us to grant out 95 cents of every net dollar raised. We fund agencies and programs in Bridgeport, Norwalk, Stamford and throughout Fairfield County that provide life's most basic necessities and help break the cycle of poverty. Our value to the community is clear—important funding combined with the leadership and expertise to allocate resources where they will provide the greatest impact. Our rigorous agency review process helps us to understand the areas of greatest need and deliver funding as quickly as possible.

Despite limited opportunities to host events, we were able to raise and grant over \$1.1 million to 108 local Fairfield County agencies. Additionally, we partnered with Fairfield County's Community Foundation to provide our agencies access to a network of business professionals offering pro bono assistance to help them strengthen their operations. One hundred agencies jointly sponsored by N&FA/FCCF availed themselves of this service resulting in thousands of hours of donated professional service. The true value of these services cannot be quantified. For many of our agencies, this assistance offered them a lifeline in the face of challenges imposed by the pandemic. They were able to re-focus and rebuild their operations.

We remain laser focused on our mission of fighting poverty where we live. We cannot do this meaningful work without donors and volunteers like you, who provide the vital support that makes these grants possible. We are truly grateful for your partnership and for the trust you continue to place in Near & Far Aid.

Margaret Mead once said, "Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful committed citizens can change the world; indeed, it's the only thing that ever has." With this in mind, we look to the future with renewed passion and energy to fight poverty, bolstered by all of you, as together we are

### **EMERGENCY SERVICES AND CRITICAL NEEDS**

Food, shelter and clothing. Sadly, thousands of people in Fairfield County don't have access to these necessities. Affordable housing and food insecurity are common predicaments for many in Fairfield County where rent can account for 70% of a family's income. One in ten families struggles to put food on the table or doesn't know where their next meal is coming from.





## **EDUCATION AND HOPE FOR THE FUTURE**

All children have a right to high-quality education, academic support and enrichment programs, regardless of zip code. That's why Near & Far Aid invests in school day, after-school and summer programs for underserved students throughout Fairfield County. Our grant support helps provide children with the resources they need, from computer access and homework assistance to nutritious snacks and physical activity. We know that education is an essential component of lifting up communities and breaking the generational cycle of poverty within families.

### **ECONOMIC SECURITY**

Near & Far Aid supports innovative approaches and partnerships that are the foundations for lasting change. Job-training programs empower those facing barriers to employment by restoring hope and offering a path that affords individuals the opportunity to provide for their family and their community. The goal is to attack systemic barriers to employment and to overcome poverty and financial insecurity by supporting job creation and skills enhancement initiatives.

# **VOLUNTEER HIGHLIGHTS**

For over 70 years, Near & Far Aid has responded to the needs of the community by funding programs that provide critical resources to underserved neighbors in Fairfield County. With additional burdens borne as a result of the pandemic, our Presidents' Council launched a new initiative, providing N&FA volunteers an

opportunity to more directly give back to the community. Our generous volunteers conducted food drives, collected diapers and toiletries, re-stocked shelves and pantries and prepared bagged lunches for local shelters. Our volunteers are our most valued asset, we are grateful for their time, talent, support and commitment to serving the needs of our greater community.





# HELPING OUR NEIGHBORS IN NEED

In September, the President's Council ran its fall Give Back Initiative in partnership with The Center for Family Justice, whose food pantry was running dangerously low due to the ongoing effects of the pandemic. Near & Far Aid board members and volunteers quickly organized a drive, filling an SUV with donations and, in just two weeks, helped restock the pantry with food, baby wipes and diapers. The Center for Family Justice, located in Bridgeport, serves to help victims and survivors of sexual and domestic violence, human trafficking, and child abuse in Fairfield County.







When N&FA heard that the Community Kitchen at the Gillespie Center was in need of bagged lunches, all hands were on deck! Over 250 lunches were prepared by the families of our volunteers with a little bit of extra love sprinkled in with hand-drawn cards. The Gillespie Center is an emergency homeless shelter in downtown Westport operated by Homes with Hope.




