A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENTS

DEAR FRIENDS,

As we reflect on another impactful year at Near & Far Aid, we want to extend our heartfelt gratitude to all our supporters. Thanks to your generosity, we granted \$1.1 million to 103 non-profit agencies across Fairfield County. Your contributions made a significant difference in providing vital services to our neighbors in need.

We deeply appreciate our generous donors and corporate sponsors, whose commitment fuels our mission. A special thank you goes to our dedicated all-volunteer board, whose tireless efforts in vetting agencies and carefully managing donated funds ensure that your trust is honored. We also want to recognize our enthusiastic volunteers, whose passion and hard work bring our fundraising events to life.

For 77 years, Near & Far Aid has been committed to addressing the root causes and effects of poverty in our community. We are keenly aware of the significant economic disparities that exist in Fairfield County, and endeavor to lessen the burden of those less fortunate among us.

The United Way of Coastal and Western Connecticut reports* that a household survival budget for a family of four in Bridgeport is \$116,580, equating to household earnings of \$58.29/hour. With more than half of the top 20 occupations in Connecticut paying an hourly wage of less than \$20—combined with decreasing eligibility for public assistance—it is no wonder that 42% of our neighbors cannot afford life's most basic necessities.

Our granting priorities include:

- Emergency food assistance, shelter, and permanent affordable housing
- Access to quality health and mental health services
- Educational opportunities for children, including after-school and summer programming
- Employment and life-skills training for adults

As we look to the future, we are inspired by the collective commitment of our non-profit partners and the unwavering support from our community. Together, we can continue to target poverty and create lasting change in the lives of those we serve.

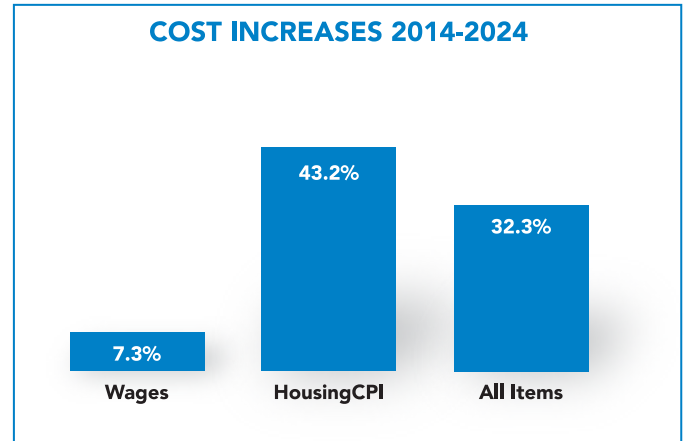
Fairfield County is home to some of the sharpest disparities in income and well-being among major metropolitan areas in the country. While residents in Fairfield County's wealthier suburban communities enjoy a high quality of life where the majority own their own home, have high paying jobs, and their children attend well-funded schools, many residents of under-resourced neighboring communities struggle to make ends meet.

Access to safe, affordable housing, quality health and mental health services, adequate and affordable transportation services, and educational opportunities for children are severely challenged. The COVID-19 Pandemic amplified the disparities that have long existed, and the gaps in income and opportunity have only widened.

CT DataHaven, analyzing data provided by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, reported that the median household income in Fairfield County in 2023 was \$101,194, higher than much of the country, but not high enough to meet the burgeoning costs of living, particularly for food and housing. The DataHaven 2023 Town Equity Reports revealed that income varied greatly within the region, with Darien recording the highest median income of \$250,001 and Bridgeport recording the lowest of \$50,597.

While wages have gone up across Fairfield County, they have not kept up with the rising costs of living.

United Way's 2024 update of the CT ALICE Report highlighted the financial challenges faced by many working families, particularly in the Bridgeport Planning Area. As illustrated in the chart below, a minimum survival budget for a family of four with two children in daycare rose to \$116,580 in 2022, requiring a combined hourly household wage of \$58.29 to be able to afford life's most basic necessities! A family with a household income of \$100,000, now considered low income, struggles to make ends meet.



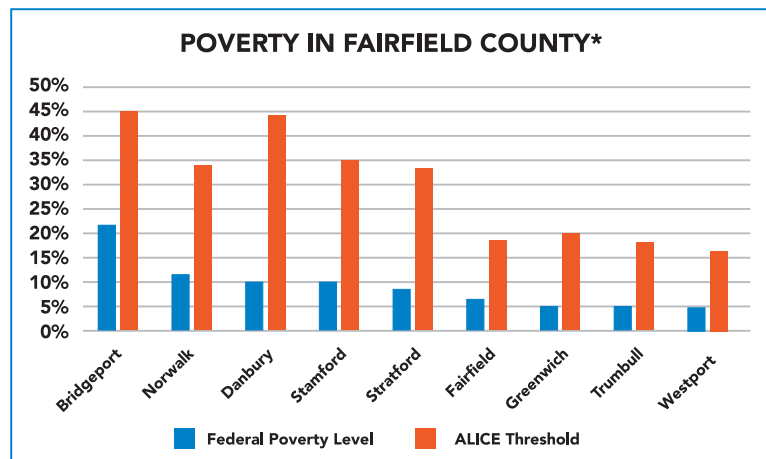

HOW WE HELP

Securing affordable safe housing is particularly challenging for lower income households. 52% of Fairfield County renters report being cost-burdened, with more than a third of their income going to rental costs. 44% of very low-income households report being severely cost burdened, with more than 50% of their income going to rental costs. With housing costs commanding a greater percentage of the household budget, families struggle to make ends meet, with little to no room for discretionary spending.

As shown in the chart below, the proportion of poor/working poor in Fairfield County towns with a population greater than 10,000 varies greatly. 66% of Bridgeport's 55,555 households are living at or below ALICE** thresholds--21% with incomes at or below the Federal poverty line. Not surprisingly, the geographic focus of Near & Far Aid's funding is concentrated in the cities suffering the most pervasive poverty.

Emergency Services and Critical Needs

Many of the agencies which Near & Far Aid funds assist with helping to shelter individuals and families who are temporarily without a safe and stable place to live, including victims of domestic violence. These households also struggle to pay for basic necessities such as housing, food, childcare and education. Our partner agencies work to help residents secure permanent supportive housing, helping to stabilize families and the broader community.



Education and Hope for the Future

A good education is essential to ensuring children have the tools to become independent and productive adults. Educated children help to break the generational cycle of poverty within families. Toward this end, Near & Far Aid supports high quality education, academic support, after-school enrichment and summer programs.



Economic Security

Consistent employment and a steady source of income are necessary components for a family's financial and social stability. Near & Far Aid funds agencies which provide job skills training, helping adults secure better, higher paying jobs to enhance their family's monetary resources and self-esteem, which in turn strengthens the fabric of their communities.



NEAR & FAR AID

Near & Far Aid has been proud to support the work of **Nourish (nOURish) Bridgeport** for over ten years. The Reverend Sara Smith, Esq., is the founder and CEO of Nourish Bridgeport, a nonprofit focused on fighting food insecurity and fostering community well-being in Bridgeport, Connecticut.

With a background in law and ministry, she transitioned to social activism, establishing Nourish Bridgeport in 2009. Under her leadership, the organization has expanded to offer various programs, including a food pantry, community dinners, and educational support. Reverend Smith's work has earned her several accolades, including the "American Dream" Award and recognition for her leadership with refugees.

Nourish Bridgeport has made a profound impact on the Bridgeport community through its innovative approach to fighting food insecurity. One of its key initiatives is a hydroponic farm, which not only produces fresh, nutrient-rich vegetables year-round but also serves as an educational tool, teaching residents about sustainable farming techniques. By using modern farming techniques, they ensure sustainable access to nutritious produce, providing local families with high-quality food and promoting healthy eating habits.



The farm enhances access to healthy foods in an area where fresh produce is often scarce, helping improve the community's overall health and wellness. The average life expectancy in Bridgeport is 60 years old, while just ten minutes away in Westport, it is 79; having access to healthy, nutritious food is a huge factor in this. The farm also employs many workers that were previously recipients of Nourish Bridgeport's services - most of whom are either immigrants or previously unhoused.



In addition to the farm, Nourish Bridgeport operates a well-organized food pantry, providing essential groceries to families in need. This pantry ensures that individuals facing food insecurity have reliable access to nutritious meals. By distributing fresh produce from the hydroponic farm alongside other staples, Nourish Bridgeport contributes to healthier eating habits and the reduction of hunger.

AGENCY SPOTLIGHT: NOURISH BRIDGEPORT

With a focus on dignity and choice, the pantry allows visitors to select items that suit their tastes and dietary needs, fostering a sense of empowerment and community. They also have a baby pantry where they distribute diapers, baby needs and infant formula when available.

Nourish Bridgeport's ESL program addresses the educational gap for non-native English speakers. By offering English as a Second Language classes, they empower individuals with the language skills necessary for employment, social interaction, and navigating essential services. This educational support helps individuals integrate more fully into society, opening doors to new opportunities. They teach English, financial literacy and citizenship weekly to over 100 immigrants and refugees from all over the world.



Finally, their mobile hot meal program brings warm, nutritious meals directly to those who need them most. By providing meals on the go, they meet the needs of the homeless, elderly, and those with limited mobility, ensuring no one goes hungry.

By offering a holistic approach that integrates education, access to fresh food, and community support, Nourish Bridgeport strengthens the social fabric and promotes long-term well-being. Through these programs, Nourish Bridgeport not only fights hunger but also nurtures growth, connection, and empowerment, fostering a healthier, more resilient community.

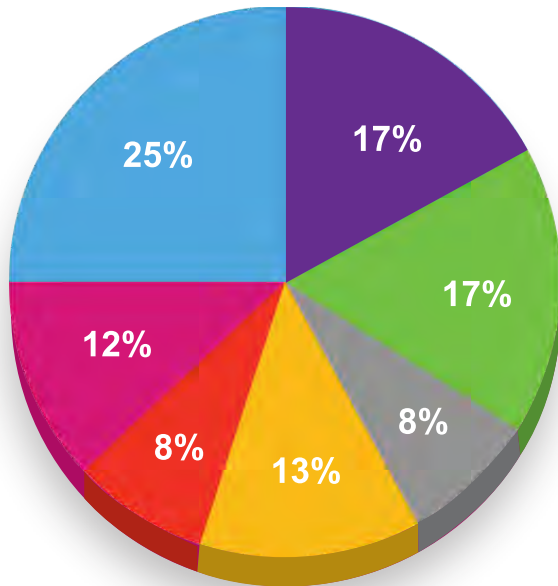

GRANT ALLOCATIONS BY AREA OF NEED



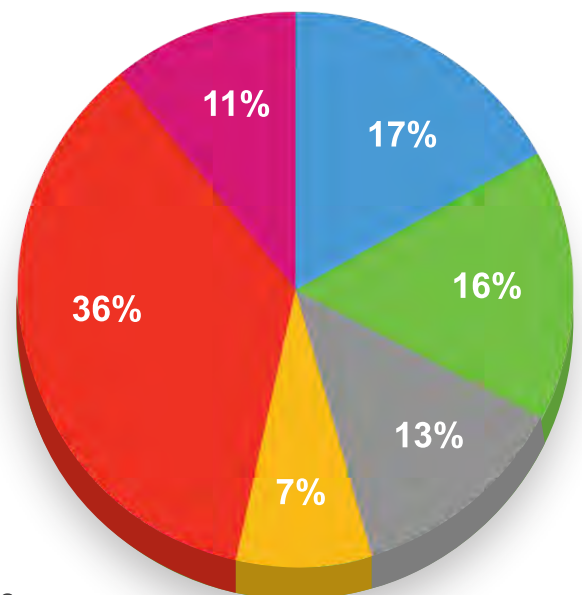
