Fairfield County is often recognized for its affluence, but beneath the surface lies a far more complex and sobering reality. Despite being home to some of the wealthiest towns in the country, nearly 40% of households in the county struggle to afford the basic cost of living. These families fall into what is called the "ALICE" population—Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed. They work, often holding down multiple jobs, but their earnings are still not enough to cover essentials such as housing, food, transportation, and childcare. In Bridgeport alone, 69% of households earn more than the federal poverty level yet cannot afford basic needs—the highest rate in the state. Other communities such as Danbury, Stratford, Norwalk, and Stamford also face steep challenges, with nearly half of families living below the ALICE threshold.

Food insecurity continues to impact thousands of our neighbors. Nearly 1 in 9 Fairfield County residents, including 1 in 6 children, lack consistent access to food. Families are forced to make impossible choices—whether to keep the lights on, pay rent, or ensure their children have enough to eat. Local food pantries and meal programs report record demand, underscoring the urgent need for both immediate relief and long-term solutions that address the root causes of hunger.

THE NEED

The crisis of homelessness is also growing. Between 2023 and 2024, the incidence of homelessness in Fairfield County rose 19%. In a recent count, 771 individuals were identified as experiencing homelessness—including 85 children. Disturbingly, the faces of homelessness are changing, with women and youth representing a growing share of those without stable shelter. Each month, approximately 150 young adults aged 18 to 24 reach out to the United Way 211 hotline in Fairfield County to report that they are homeless, a stark reminder of how many young people are at risk of falling through the cracks.

These struggles do not exist in isolation. Poverty, food insecurity, and homelessness ripple outward—affecting physical and mental health, children's education, and community well-being. While agencies and nonprofits across the region are working tirelessly to provide relief and support, the scale of the challenge continues to outpace resources. The statistics represent more than numbers; they reflect the daily hardship of thousands of our neighbors. In one of the nation's wealthiest counties, the persistence of such need calls for compassion, awareness, and collective action—and it is precisely this mission that Near & Far Aid embraces every day, directing vital resources where they are needed most to strengthen our community.




2024-2025 GRANT ALLOCATIONS

Trivia Night reminded us that while some questions are answered with clever guesses and teamwork, the bigger questions facing our neighbors—how to afford their next meal, keep a roof overhead, or pay for childcare—require a community coming together to find solutions.

Near & Far Aid works tirelessly to raise funds and immediately grant them out to local agencies that do the hard work on the ground—feeding families, providing shelter, and creating pathways toward stability. Trivia Night not only brought people together for an evening of joy and camaraderie but also underscored the urgency of our mission: ensuring that no family in Fairfield County has to struggle alone.
